FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

CROESO / WELCOME

To the 2026 Jones o Gymru Anglesey Half Marathon & 10K. This document contains all the information you'll need to have a great day and a safe race.

EVENT DAY TIMINGS

07:30 - 08:30: Half Marathon number collection.

08:00 - 09:00: 10km number collection.

08:45: Half Marathon compulsory race briefing at the race start.

09:00: Half Marathon race start.

09:15: 10k compulsory race briefing at the race start.

09:30: 10k race start.

If you opted to have your race number bib posted, it will be posted out to you 3 weeks before the event. If you entered within 21 days of the event, opted to collect your bib or live outside the UK, you will need to collect your bib from Number Collection.

Number Collection is located in the event village close to the race start. If you are collecting your bib, please check the **RACE CHECKER** to find your number beforehand. This will also show if you opted for bib postage.

Race starts are at the Anglesey Showground, Gwalchmai: **LL65 4RW**

CAR PARKING

Car parking is available on site for the first 500 cars. When this is full there is overflow parking available at Mona industrial estate, parking is charged at £5 per car and is payable on exit.

The overflow car park is 20 minutes walk away from the event village; please leave plenty of time to park and get to the start.

Please approach the event site on the A5 from Llangefni. Following the event, when leaving the site, please follow signage and marshal instruction to rejoin the A55 diversion at Treban.

GENERAL INFORMATION

RACE TIMING

You must wear your race number which you will have either received in the post or be collecting from our number collection.

Remember your number. NO Number, NO RACE!

Should you forget your number, a limited number of spares will be available on a first-come, first-served basis at Number Collection for the price of £5. Please wear your number prominently on the front of the torso; ensure it is not covered by clothing.

LIVE RESULTS

The 2026 Jones o Gymru Anglesey Half Marathon and 10k features live results by TDL Event Services. The live results page also shows when participants pass various sections on the course. Race results will be live online on the day of the event at: <https://my.raceresult.com/383791>

HIGH5 RE-FUELLING STATIONS

These stations will be available at approximately 3, 6 and 9 miles (5K for 10K runners) serving HIGH5 Zero electrolyte drink, water and HIGH5 Energy Gels. Where possible, please carry your own bottle to help us reduce waste.

TOILETS

There will be portaloos and urinals at the race start and finish. There will also be portaloos on the race course. The locations will be detailed in your Safety Briefing.

PRIZE GIVING: Timings are approximate, please be aware that they may be delayed on the day.

12:00: Half Marathon & 10k

Award ceremonies will take place in the event village : **LL65 4RW**
All prizes must be collected on the day and cannot be posted after the event.

EVENT VILLAGE & FINISH LINE

BAG DROP: 08:00 - 09:15

Located in the event village, close to Number Collection. The bag drop will be crewed by marshals. Please label your bag clearly with your number on a prominent part of your bag. Tags will be available but it speeds everything up if you do this before you arrive.

ALWAYS AIM HIGH MERCHANDISE STORE

This is where you can pick up your pre-paid hoodies and t-shirts. If you have not pre-ordered there will be a limited number of t-shirts and hoodies for sale in the shop.

ALL MERCHANDISE MUST BE COLLECTED ON THE DAY AND CANNOT BE POSTED AFTER THE EVENT.



SAFETY BRIEFING

All competitors must attend the compulsory safety briefing in the start area on race day as detailed in event day timings above.

CUT OFF TIMES

Half Marathon runners arriving at Bodffordd (approx. 10 miles) after 11:30 will not be permitted to continue in the race. A vehicle will be available to take you back to the event village. Finish line timing ends at 12:30.

LITTERING

Any person found littering will be immediately disqualified from the event and banned from all Always Aim High Events. Please respect the beautiful location you are running in and dispose of any gel wrappers or other consumables responsibly. You may dispose of your litter at the designated litter points and with event marshals.

MEDICAL ACCIDENT AND EMERGENCY

RACE DAY EMERGENCY CONTACT

If you pull out of the race having started, or need to speak to someone urgently on race day about the race, please call 07527 034 308. This phone number is for the race duration only and will not be activated at any other times.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

The course takes place on closed roads. Marshals will be in place to direct you and Traffic Management is in place to direct traffic. Please follow marshal instructions and event signage

All roads are closed, however please be vigilant of vehicles and note that all roads are open to emergency service vehicles.

The use of bone conduction headphones is permitted. Any other headphones are strictly not allowed.

EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY

We are excited to be working with **Mel Parry Photography** at this year's event. Photos will be available after the race on their dedicated online gallery. You can **pre-register** with a selfie to be notified when your photos are online.

If you have pre-purchased photo packages, a code will be sent to you directly by the event photographer. Please expect to receive an email from them, and be sure to check your junk email if this hasn't arrived.



RACE DAY MASSAGE

Free 5-minute pre-race activation, and post-race massage will be available in the Event Village. Level 3 students from Coleg Llandrillo will be available on a first-come, first-served basis from 08:00am.
